

Ecla Paris-Villejuif student housing, the first French residential building to obtain the WELL Performance Rating!

Paris and Montpellier, November 21, 2024 – UXCO Group, investor, developer and operator of student housing and co-living real estate (PBSA), proudly announces that Ecla Paris-Villejuif has achieved the WELL Performance Rating. This distinction, a global first for a student residence and a national first across all real estate sectors in France, reflects the group's strategic commitment to investing in high-quality assets. UXCO Group places resident comfort and well-being at the core of its priorities, while reaffirming its ambition to promote sustainable and high-performing real estate.



An internationally recognised label

Today, 56% of the world's population lives in cities. We spend nearly 90% of our days indoors, in an enclosed space, with a limited supply of outside air and natural light.

It is on the basis of this observation that WELL Certification was launched ten years ago: if we spend so much time in buildings, it is essential that they are designed for its occupants and built with a view to guaranteeing their good health and well-being.

Developed by the **International WELL Building Institute (IWBI)**, this certification is based on scientific research that demonstrates the impact of the built environment on the health, comfort and productivity of users. In the same vein, IWBI has released a specific rating based on the WELL Standard focused on measurement: **the WELL Performance Rating.**



The WELL Performance Rating approach is built around the following themes:

• Indoor air quality and thermal conditions

Minimization of risks associated with airborne contaminants and improved thermal comfort.

• Water Quality Management

Improved water quality to promote safer hydration.

• Light Measurements

Optimizing illuminated environments for visual acuity and helping to improve sleep, productivity, and concentration.

• Acoustic performance

Limit background noise and distractions to promote well-being and concentration.

• Environmental monitoring

Monitoring building performance in real-time by analyzing sensor data and on-site tests.

• Occupant Experience

Collecting feedback on how people perceive spaces.

All WELL programmes, and particularly the WELL Performance Rating, offer reliable guarantees because the criteria of indoor air quality, water quality, thermal, light and acoustic comfort are verified on site using certified measurement equipment, and according to a precise protocol respected by the WELL Performance Testing Providers (PTP).

Globally, more than 20,000 buildings have already been awarded WELL Certification and associated ratings, in more than 135 countries. In France, several tertiary buildings have achieved WELL Certification, but the WELL Performance Rating of Ecla Paris-Villejuif marks a historic first in France and in the student housing sector.

Ecla Paris-Villejuif, a residence built around well-being

UXCO Group puts the transformation of lifestyles at the heart of its purpose. The real estate group is committed to offering an innovative living environment, conducive to the development and well-being of its residents.

The achievement of the Ecla Paris-Villejuif residence, the first student residence in France to be WELL Performance Rated, testifies to this commitment and confirms an intuition that the Group has been maturing for several years now: housing must be real living spaces that catalyze energies and contribute to the success of residents.

This approach takes on its full meaning in the Ecla Paris-Villejuif residence, designed around "Care". Developed in collaboration with the Think Tank "Les Murs ont des idées" and designed by the Group's promotion structure, Océanis Promotion, this residency invites well-being and personal development.

Indeed, two housing atmospheres have been imagined by Studio Chantal Peyrat, an architectural design firm:

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- the "Active design" atmosphere, which is based on the well-being of the body. Balls replace chairs, desks allow you to work in a sitting or standing position, and facilities allow you to practice a sports activity.
- the "Ma" atmosphere, Japanese art based on the well-being of the mind. These homes offer large storage spaces and modular furniture, allowing space to be optimized.

Within the common areas, the visual atmospheres vary to adapt to the times of day. Fitness areas, yoga and a sauna are available to residents and important green spaces have been created, nearly 100 trees have been planted, the façade of the residence is green and is completed by a planted patio and green terraces.

Finally, this rating embodies UXCO Group's CSR approach. Indeed, aware of the crucial importance of social inclusion and well-being, particularly for students and young workers at a pivotal period in their lives, the Group's CSR commitments are built around three pillars: the planet, people and cities, to:

- Guaranteeing a habitat that respects its environment with a continuous improvement approach with a measurable impact
- To provide a life experience that is both stimulating and rewarding, based on a responsible, bold approach and driven by the strength of the collective
- Promote living spaces that are open to the city and engaged in the daily lives of residents

To carry out this project, UXCO Group was accompanied by G-ON, a consulting and engineering company in sustainable development, which guided them throughout the WELL Performance Rating process.

Regulated measurements on health and comfort levels have been carried out by a dedicated entity, G-ON Life, which has the status of WELL Performance Testing Provider. This entity is approved to carry out third-party measurements according to a strict protocol.
